**MINUTES OF THE MCR EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING HELD AT 19.30 ON JANUARY 28th
2008**

1. Apologies

2. MCR Stash

Mike Hargreaves has been investigating the ordering of a stash for the MCR, and asked about the sort of items we would be looking for. 3. Feedback

Dave Clark pointed out that there had been several rumours spreading around the MCR which should be stopped. To this effect, an anonymous feedback system will be shortly implemented on the newly redesigned website, thanks to Tim Rawle.

4. Lunch with the Vice-Chancellor

Dave Clark said he'd been given several invitations to a lunch on Sunday 2nd March with the VP to be passed around the Exec. The exec should get back to him with their availability.

5. Formals

There will be no more MCR tables at formals this term. There has been an MCR table at more formals than usual over the past two terms. Jess Bowers and Bex Joss suggested that next year, a new system should be implemented in which the 4th year members choose at the beginning of the year whether they will be booking into formals through the MCR or JCR.

6. Long-term MCR plans

Dave Clark reported that during the coming summer's refurbishment of Elvet block, the Phoenix room would be required as a base for the workers. The MCR will be temporarily relocated to the Snooker Room. When this work is completed, the MCSR will move back to the Phoenix Room which will have received some refurbishment.

7. MCR-SCR Formal

This will take place on the 5th March. It is shaping up to be an enjoyable event. Currently, plans are for the JCR to provide a drinks reception in the Old Library for everyone attending. There will be a full hall. MCR and SCR members will be split into pairs and distributed

around the hall to increase interaction with the JCR. There will be 32 places available for MCR members. Afterwards, the SCR will provide port and cheese in the SCR for the SCR and MCR attendees, plus invited JCR members. The MCR will provide a financial contribution.
